Uncontested No-Fault Divorce

An uncontested or no-fault divorce in Virginia can be granted on the grounds of living separate and apart, continuously and without interruption for the statutory period. The parties must have lived separate and apart without cohabitation or interruption for a period of at least 12 months. If there are no minor children born of or adopted of the marriage and the parties have a signed property settlement agreement, a no-fault divorce can be obtained after a separation of 6 months. We perform no-fault divorces for a flat-fee if the parties are in agreement.

A note about Property Settlement Agreements:

In Virginia, Separation Agreements, also known as Property, Custody, Visitation and Marital Agreements, are contracts between parties that will resolve all issues that are usually considered as part of a divorce, before the parties actually file for divorce. Issues that can usually be governed by this agreement include, but are not limited to: division of property, child support, spousal support, child custody/visitation, division of pension/retirement, tax planning, and insurance coverage. There are many benefits to having a separation agreement. Within the document, the parties agree to resolve all issues that are potential conflicts, and the rights of the parties are protected by this agreement which is a contract enforceable by the Court. Added to the security and stability of a Property Settlement Agreement, it will also reduce the waiting period from 12 months to 6 months if the parties have no minor children and are seeking a no-fault divorce.
